Abstract

The usage of public transport is not always easy, especially - but not only – for people with limited mobility, for example because of

- Not clearly laid out Information (hard to read, different layouts ..)
- Weak familiarity of certain target groups (elderly) with the information media (internet)
- Complicated handling of ticket dispensers
- Vehicles and stops are not barrier-free
