railjet is the new high speed train of Austrian railways and connects the cities of Budapest, Vienna – and of course the European cultural capital 2009 Linz - and Munich. Additional to the economy and first class the railjet has a Premium Class with an outstanding service and extremely comfortable seats. Very special is also the passenger information system with about 80 screens in the train, not only showing the actual position, but also the current velocity and further stations. This information system got also a "LINK" called system to show all passengers their connecting possibilities at the next stop. The information shown is real time and gives an overview of departure times and the platform information.
